



WMD/Terrorism Incident **Defensive Operations for Emergency Responders**

This course focuses on the special challenges faced by responders in dealing with a WMD or terrorist incident. Upon completion, participants will be able to respond to a WMD/Hazmat incident in a **defensive mode**. Responders will be able to preclude the spread of the hazard to the public and the environment. The WMD Operations course provides the knowledge and skills needed to obtain certification through NPQS (ProBoard) at the Hazardous Materials Operations level. The course is designed around **lectures, interactive exercises, and group scenarios**.

Participant Audience:

Awareness level emergency personnel who will respond to an incident involving a WMD/terrorist incident and hazardous materials. Course participants may include:

- Fire Department personnel
- Law enforcement personnel
 - Public works
- County/state/federal responders
- Hospital and pre-hospital medical providers
- County, state, and federal personnel who will respond with a local jurisdiction during a WMD/terrorist incident

Entry Level Objectives:
