Dear Speaker Pelosi, Majority Leader Hoyer, Chairman Lantos, and Honorable Murtha, Boehner, and Ros-Lehtinen:

Prior to leaving for the August recess, I submitted H. Con. Res. 201, which requests an Iraqi referendum to ascertain whether or not the Iraqi people want us to continue to be a presence in their country. I urge this legislation be brought up expeditiously.

No matter what your position is on the current situation in Iraq, it is imperative that Congress have the information as to whether or not the Iraqi people are indeed supporting our presence there. This letter is to request that shortly after we return from our recess, this piece of legislation be brought up so that the people of Iraq can express themselves and we can base our decisions on a full understanding of what the people of Iraq want as well as what's in the United State's interest.

As the surge comes to a close we need to have the aforementioned information available to us, therefore I would respectfully request H. Con. Res. 201 be brought up for consideration in very short order.
