UNITED STATES SERVICE ACADEMIES – CONGRESSIONAL NOMINATION

If you are a student who lives in the 46th Congressional District and seeking nomination to a United States Service Academy you should contact my Nominations Director, Tony Capitelli at 714-960-6483 or 310-377-9493.

The United States Service Academies - Air Force, Naval, West Point, Merchant Marine, and Coast Guard - accept students through a congressional nomination process. To be eligible for my nomination, applicants must be an unmarried, United States citizen, between the ages of 17-23, with a high school education or equivalent, demonstrate high academic achievement, earn competitive scores on the SAT, and a participant in extracurricular and/or community endeavors highlighting leadership qualities.

Defense Department Adopts New Policy for Seriously Injured Servicemen

The Department of Defense recently announced a new procedure to expedite service members who are seriously injured in combat from military to veteran status. This allows veterans to receive benefits in three to four months in comparison to the traditional lengthy process.
